Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes: 13 October 2025
At First Baptist Church, Leander TX

Meeting called to order by Denny Springer @ 6:30 pm

Attendance: Scott Childress, Ben Marquardt, Denny Springer, Aleta Wilder

Test for Well #2: Some questions on proposed water flow testing for Well #2 were addressed by Chris Richie of Advanced Water Well Technologies, LLC, which was invited to quote on the testing by Ryan. The company provides testing and “refurbishment” of water wells, but no drilling. The quote for ~\$12,200 only covers the water flow test. The company would then specify a pump/motor/controller. The test would be conducted to the requirements set by the Board (e.g., with well #2 running or not, etc.). The proposed new placement of pump/motor in well #2 is closer to the ground level than the original placement (i.e., well #2 has lost depth due to cave-in as shown in the video that was summarized in a file & sent to the Board). Aleta expressed concern that there is risk that well #2 walls could continue to cave-in as the well is uncased below 89 feet. It was noted that we do not understand why well #1 has quit providing water and it may be due to similar cave-in behavior. Casing well #2 to the current water level would add to the refurbishment cost. A decision of abandoning the idea of cleaning out the cave-in debris in well #2 would need to be made before approving the funds for the water flow test.

Issue from the Floor: Terry Hagood, Representative of New Owner of Signal Hill property adjacent to the HGWSC wells requested change to private road 949 that has an easement on HGWSC lot. A topographical drawing was presented of the road change. This change was specified by the Fire Marshall of Williamson County to the New Owner & Terry Hagood. New Owner plans to build a commercial event facility on the Signal Hill property. Property has one HGWSC tap. New Owner stated plans to install a septic system and non-potable water well. This is the same Owner that Chuck told last year that HGWSC would not provide water to a high population density housing development on that property.

- Scott made motion to table discussion on road change, Aleta 2nd, motion passed 4-0-0.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 pm was made by Denny, Aleta 2nd, motion passed with a vote 4-0-0.
